

My Testimony ~ Sister Jennifer M. Rodriguez

I have been seriously contemplating what to write for my testimony , so much has gone on especially in the last 12 years its almost overwhelming. I don't think there is enough time to write a full account of events but I will sum it up as best as possible.

I was about 15 months old when my parents got saved in NTCC . My dad was stationed in Germany and had been invited to church as a young soldier. My dad's life had been radically changed from the New York thug he once was. Now all he wanted was to serve God , to become a preacher. I remember as a very young child, my dad would spend hours , sometimes all night reading his Bible and praying. All through my childhood even as an adult I remember him doing this. I am by no means saying he was perfect, that he never made mistakes and people were hurt (I have known many ministers, and have yet to meet a perfect one). I am saying that my dad was somebody that I knew really loved God and people.

Through my life I remember him pleading with people for their souls, going out of his way to find people he knew were hurting. We used to say he could talk to a tree about God. I remember several times he would get calls in the middle of the night from people who were going to commit suicide. (there is one lady currently in Hinesville , I remember several times my parents had to stop her). Even gang members would call my dad when something was going to go down, and he would drive there and the ruckus would stop. There was a girl that the doctors said there was no way she would make it, if she did make it she would be a complete vegetable. her brain had swelled so badly from falling off of a car, while car surfing that they had to cut some of her skull out. My dad was called to pray for her and the girl miraculously walked out of the hospital not forgetting one phone number! I remember he would give people money he didn't even have, pay the church bills on his credit card, buy things for people in need, let them live with us, etc. Many of these things were against the rules of NTCC. He wasn't perfect but he did the best he could with what he knew, and under the régime of NTCC. The intention here is not by any means to lift up a man, only Jesus is to be lifted up. My intentions are to show how off the road Rev. Denis has taken him. I wish to God that the man who allowed God to use him then would come back, instead of listening to RONY DENIS WHO HAS DESTROYED HIM. I know the hand of God was upon my dad at one time.

I believe it was about 1999 when Rev. Denis started coming to CA. He would visit the NTCC in Oceanside, CA which was about 45minutes away from our church in San Diego. We would drive to Oceanside sometimes daily to spend time with the Denis's. At this time Rev. Denis would teach constantly about prayer ,my dad being one who loved to pray was really drawn to Rev. Denis and his teachings. Often we had very intense prayer meetings. I remember loving to listen to sis. Denis pray, she prayed with such fluency as a women it was amazing to

me, and I wanted so much to be able to pray that way. During this time I really began to love the Denis's very much. During my teenage years she was such a blessing to me, becoming a second mother to me, praying for me and with me. Much like my dad, Sis. Denis seemed to be able to talk to anybody about God. This Sis. Denis no longer exist, she has been replaced by a beaten down, silent robot. It breaks my heart to see what has been done to her.

Around 2002 after NTCC conferences, we would go the Drury Inn in St. Louis for "Prayer Force" meetings with just a handful of ministers. Here Rev. Denis would teach, we would have prayer meetings, we would go out to eat and the ladies would take some time to shop together while the men stayed at the hotel fellowshiping. This was the beginning of the split from NTCC. These meetings were secret meetings, if NTCC leadership found out it would blow the top off of Rev. Denis's plan to split from them. At this time we were told the split was for "righteous" reasons. We were told that Rev. Davis had compromised, he was allowing things in the church that he previously preached against. We were told that he did this because he allowed his family to run him, he let down the standard for his grandson, etc. We were supposed to start a "movement" that didn't contain all of the politics, sin, divorce, miss use of people, on and on it went. It was supposed to be a dream church. I now wonder if any of these were his real intentions, I now wonder if he just wanted his own empire. He has spent the last 12 almost 13 years trying to outdo both Rev. Davis and his father who was a very evil man in Haiti, both of whom are dead. HOPCC has all of the things Rev. Denis said it wouldn't have, plus more than NTCC could have thought up. Including many unbiblical divorces, of which he said NTCC would be judged for doing. Rev Denis now say God has "authorized him" to divorce anyone. My friend, please listen to me for a moment..... **GOD DOES NOT CHANGE THE BIBLE FOR ANYBODY, INCLUDING THE "PREACHER"**. (Mal 3:6) (Heb 13:8)

In the beginning of HOPCC it did seem as if Rev. Denis was trying to implement some of the things he had intended to, to make this "movement" something we hadn't seen before. Revival of the world seemed to be the goal, helping other churches is what was constantly spoken about. In the beginning he would say "we are brethren", He would actually say "preach to me". He would say if he wasn't on the platform he was a member. he didn't seem to want any esteemed position, he would say he was there to help. (Now he says he should have never come down to our level, he should have never eaten with us.) Rev Denis would tell us that God had given him three things to live by:

- "It's not wrong to be wrong, it's wrong to stay wrong"
- "I can be wrong"
- "Remember your just a man"

Although even in the early days things were rocky at times, some things seemed strange but we road with it. We never asked for or even wanted a perfect pastor, we were fine with his imperfections we were fine with a "man" for a pastor, nobody asked for a "spirit" which is what he says he is now. At this time he would even speak of them over the pulpit, he would say that God was working on him with these things. Where he started thinking he had to be perfect I'm really not sure, but that's what happened. He said years back that he was "near perfect" now he says he's "DIETY".

Rev Denis slowly began to blame everybody else for things that went wrong. If someone had enough nerve to say "sir, you told me to do it this way" he would say "I never said that"! in the end even God has been blamed for the problems. I've heard him countless times with my own ears arguing with God, blaming God. I've heard him saying God calls him a "big, fat pig" a "Ni**er". (what kind of Holy God speaks like that?) I've heard him asking different preachers , (my husband included) to pray and ask God why God gave them a "Ni**er for a pastor". He asks if God is prejudice constantly, stating that people don't respect him because "I'm black". He once said this is why he leaves the church early, because he's " black" and "doesn't belong there". I really didn't understand it when he started using the race card like this, people WORSHIP him! I was so confused at how he could possibly believe people did not respect him, as he says because he's "black".

Rev. Denis constantly says that people treated Rev. Davis better, because he was a tall white man. From my memory of NTCC people did worship rev. Davis, but nowhere near the degree that Rev. Denis is worshiped and FEARED in HOPCC. I've never seen my parents fear Rev. Davis, the way both of them are terrified of Rev. Denis. I've seen **senior ministers** turn into babies in the presence of Rev. Denis. (He enjoys this, what a shame!) The last few months we were there I listened to him call the ministers one by one and coerce them into admitting to being prejudice, (even ministers who are also black) some had to confess to this and other crazy things publically. (Rev. Denis is a master of coercing false confessions)

Things in HOPCC have continued to grow stranger over the years. The praise that was once not excepted was now expected. The servitude that was once asked for and people were willing to comply, is now demanded with severe punishment if the task wasn't done the way it was wanted. (pharaoh?) The man who once said " preach to me", now humiliates a senior minister, every chance possible for nothing more than taking him up on this, 10 years ago! (" I don't forgive, or forget"?) This is the man who said "There are houses of Prayer all over the world", now he says HOPCC is the only church and he's the only "Man of God". He is the only one saved, the only "holiness preacher". He is the only man that can be trusted with kids, all

men have feelings for their daughters. all men are child molesters, all men are gay. All men lust over all the women, he is the only man without the ability to lust, even over his own wife. I could go on and on. This is by far not the same man I knew as a kid, nor is he the man who brought us to HOPCC. There is a complete contrast, its staggering to sit and contemplate this. The only conclusion is that he has become a different man entirely, unless this is who he always was and he hid it well.... I really don't know anymore.

Things seemed to go completely out of control maybe a year and a half ago. This is when Rev. Denis would have us over his house to show us the "secrets of the universe". This is when he had started showing us the numerology that he said God was teaching him, later he said he got it from the rabbi. He would have a calculator and a stack of white paper he would do these strange equations on. He would use the letters of our name to come up with a number that was supposed to represent each person. He would also do the same with our birthdays. Then he started reading our palms and drawing with a pen what he saw on our hands. All of this was supposed to coincide. The only ones he did this were mainly those in his inner circle (including my son) with a couple exceptions. I think he knew if he went public with this people would revolt. We were all told not to tell anybody.

Toward the end of last year this seemed to peak. This is when Rev Denis would say that he had something only Jesus had, out of his breathe came the Holy Ghost. (this is why he breathes into the polycom) He would say every word was directed by God and his eyes would constantly go back and forth as if he's listening to something. This is when he claimed to be Deity, said God had told him the date of the rapture. He said he was part of the decisions of heaven. This would include world events and the election. He prophesied that Hillary Clinton would win. (Did she?) Rev Denis started having the different preachers from the different churches bring all of their members outside to "see the wonders of God" he would say an airplane would come, or watch him move the son, or birds are going to show up, clouds will move and take on specific shapes, stars would move, etc. This is something that would go on day and night for quite awhile with the ministers. He would call the different ministers, my husband included and have them go outside and tell him what they saw. They were supposed to look for "signs" in the sky.(Matt 12:39) Owls hooting while he would teach were seen as validation of him being a man of God. We would go for walks at night and this would go on, he would say he had seen and heard more than we did because God was showing him directly. Later he would say all of this was "witch craft", He would say the birds were "sexual Deity". Those are his words, not mine.

Once Rev Denis realized that the 2'9 Spirit and "Abba Yahweh" was not "God" as he once said, he went on a full campaign to destroy those who knew what was going on. Especially the ministers who had heard him say he was "DIETY". He was making sure at this point that the

only one the people would listen to is him. I would sit at his houses and watch as he completely desecrated these men leaving them, empty carcass. (he would go out of his way to call my dad, when I was there) He was claiming at this time to be so angry with them that he couldn't speak to them. He would have Jeff Derby call (he is very disrespectful to them, knowing he has Rev Denis backing) these ministers, putting the phone on speaker (usually with an audience listening) and ask them very crazy questions, all to humiliate and break them down. I've watched as they were made to disclose very intimate details of their marriage lives. (with no knowledge of who's listening) These details were used to make them all confess to being gay. This was mainly done with the senior ministers, although it was also done to some of the younger ones also. Rev Denis has an affinity for speaking about peoples bedroom publically. There were nights I left his house shaking, I couldn't believe the filthy stuff I would here come out of his mouth, stuff I've never known in my life. very disturbing.....

These preachers were treated so badly from the point he realize these spirits weren't God, until we left. (they should thank us, we gave them their "freedom" to talk to him again) one day Rev Robertson had tried to answer a question while Rev Denis was on the polycom. he was told he didn't want to talk to him, that he was a hypocrite in front of the whole church. (who is the real hypocrite?) Another time Rev Robertson was preaching and Rev Denis walked out, and called the polycom telling the church that he didn't know what he was talking about. There was a time Rev Bradeen had to confess to never being saved in front of the whole church. over and over all of the ministers were publically humiliated wither in front of the church or a group of people at Rev Denis house. This was to make sure the ministers didn't attempt an uprising after he had done all of this sin himself. he had to be sure the members wouldn't listen to them. (the bad thing is they really believe he has the power to do the things he claims)

The worst part of this is my son has seen all of the things that have gone on with the Spiritism garbage. He is one of the few kids who were allowed to have such close access, he has seen allot. He was told " not to ask God to make him a preacher, the ministry is garbage". He has had his palm read, he was there in the "Deity" meeting when Rev Denis said he saw God walking around us, when it turned out to be spirits and not God at all. He was told during this time he was the "high priest". (Jesus is our high priest) He heard Rev Denis arguing with God and fighting with spirits .(which he does all day when outsiders aren't around) He has been there for all of this stuff and more than I have time to write. Would you stay and allow your child to be destroyed by this stuff?

My husband and I decided that leaving was the only option that we had, obviously an option I hadn't ever fathomed doing. I really believe God gave me an extra measure of Grace, I really do. How it is that I was able to see clearly I really don't know, really should be the biggest yes man there, Thank God for his great grace! Leaving church is something I had been

trained my entire life not to do. I've been taught all of the propaganda and really I've seen with my own eyes, People who leave church always get very messed up. I've since realized this happens when people leave not only church, but they also leave God. Which by Gods grace is not anything we had planned to do. HOPCC doesn't have a monopoly on heaven. Jesus died for the WHOLE world. Before we had even left Hinesville God had put a pastor in our heart, a place we could really learn of the grace of God the way the Bible teaches. We had hung on as long as we could, we watched and prayed hoping the senior ministers would get up and fight. They didn't do it, they allowed themselves to be destroyed. We could no longer sit there and allow our child to be destroyed, which was obviously about to happen.

With the exception of Bro Derby and Rev Pilkington, Rev. Benton, and Bro. Fryar, who know **everything** that has gone on,(if they tell you otherwise they are lying) The ministers hadn't seen everything we had. But they had seen enough to know enough of what was going on. Most had been in the meeting that Rev Denis had said he was "DIETY" they had heard him say God gave him the power to kill everybody there. He had said if anybody didn't except the changes they would die (doesn't **Jesus** have the keys of death, hell and the grave?) He said he was above everybody in the Bible, that he's "in the room". meaning he makes the decisions with the Godhead. I know this stuff sounds farfetched but trust me it not, this stuff really happened. if any of the ministers would tell the truth they would validate my claims. The sad thing is Rev Denis actually has them lying for him, so I'm very sure they will just cover it up. This grieves me so badly to see these ministers who gave God their live at very young ages have been reduced to this. it's so sad.

I have to say leaving the only thing I have ever known, was the hardest thing I have ever done. Before we left I would look at those that we really loved. The girls I really fought for and were now being destroyed, and it would break my heart that we couldn't tell them anything. we couldn't even tell them how evil this man has become that they believe to be so great. We grieved for the Robertson's, we love them so much. We knew shortly these people wouldn't understand, they would soon believe us to be devils, believing whatever lies and propaganda that would soon come over the pulpit. Even still we knew we had to do it, we just hoped that someday they will understand. I never in my life thought I would have to leave a church and on top of that have to hide from the very people I've known all my life.

When we decided to leave we started slowly moving our stuff to storage. We did this carefully because Anthony Oloans had an office in our back room for 5 years.(not by any choice of ours) He was always coming and going at crazy hours and walking through our house, giving us absolutely no privacy at all. (even though we were the ones that paid the \$1250 rent, he acted as if the house was his) He liked to call Rev Denis about everything we did, so we knew we had to do this without him getting in our business. (which he often liked to do) we

didn't get to finish this operation because my husband wanted to talk to a brother that our families had been very close throughout HOPCC. The brother wouldn't even hear him out, he walked out and called on him. As close as we all had been all these years, as much as we were there for them when things happened, you would think he would have listened to what he said at least, but he didn't. I'm so thankful that I had kept my son home on this day, I know they would have tried to keep him from me. My husband called and said he had been called on we were just going to have to leave our stuff and get out of town.

I was trying to throw clothes in garbage bags as fast as I could. The ministers began calling my phone excessively, than Oloans comes out and yells at my son saying, "you're not going anywhere, do you understand me"? He runs to my room and hides under the blankets shaking, while Oloans continues to call him. I couldn't believe he was actually trying to get my kid! Then Oloans lets two of the maintenance guys in they start walking in my room, I slammed it and locked it. Rev Denis is on their phone telling them to bust in my room, so they bust in the door. They have Rev. Denis on their speaker phone yelling to me, which I didn't respond. I really couldn't believe they would do this. While they were busting in my room Oloans was in the garage padlocking both sides of the garage (only the fire department could cut them off), disarming the garage door opener, and ripping the battery out of my truck. (I feel so bad for whoever they are making pay that \$850 payment, after Oloans messed up the wires. They will never tell the person either) My husband had called the cops, which none of them would let in the house. My husband comes home very upset by the current circumstances and lets the cops in. They would later say that the spirit of God had left him, because he was upset by THEIR actions.

We ended up leaving most of our stuff in Hinesville, we took all of our clothes and some other things that we could get while the police were there. They couldn't stay to long so we had to leave most of the house, but it's ok God has taken care of us! Since the time we left Hinesville we have been stalked. We stopped at my mother in laws house, 5 minutes after we got there she was getting phone calls about us. (obviously they had a steak out watching) She continued to get calls, visits, and drive bys even after we had left there. Our phones were turned off on us, we have had our bank account attempting to be hacked on three different occasions. The last was a couple days ago. Is this desperation or what??? We have also gotten emails threatening and blackmailing us. Do you still think these are nice people??? Christians???? Rev Denis has had Oloans take over my mom's email and try and impersonate her. (he is an awful impersonator) They have used my dad against me, I'm guessing Rev Denis thinks my dad can break me down. (my dad doesn't seem to realize how evil this man has become) Rev Denis knows what we are saying is all truth, but has told my dad it's all lies. My husband and I and the Yorkes have been accused falsely of every sin that someone could ever imagine. It's almost

humorous, being that before we left he would talk of how clean Sharita Yorke and I are, we leave and now we are everything under the son. How is that possible, and how is that nobody question these types of inconsistencies?? (they happen constantly)

Rev. Denis says that we have been given over to the Devil because we left HOPCC when actually God has been so good to us. I have one question for those who believe this "why did you leave NTCC"? If it's wrong to leave HOPCC then we should have never left NTCC, because evidently that was wrong also. The truth is we left NTCC for so much less than has gone on in HOPCC. Rev Davis never read palms and got involved in Spiritim. Giving the church over to this 2'9 spirit that he claimed was the fullness of God, later saying it was spirits. Rev Davis never destroyed peoples credit for 12 years with no intentions of fixing it, infringing on people livelihood. Neither was he involved in all of this real estate fraud.

My point in writing this testimony is not to trash Rev. Denis. I once loved this man very much, I will still pray for him. I can no longer sit and watch him destroy people and not say anything. I know what he once was and what he is now, I am here to tell you this is not the same man he once was. We gave this man almost 13 years of our life, and our marriage we have done everything he asked of us. We had very little time as a family, any time we had as a family was usually about 2 or 3 in the morning. My husband has spent all of these years serving Rev. Denis sometimes coming home long after midnight, even on holidays when everyone else has a day off. (although Rev Denis says he was just a "toilet paper runner") All of this without pay, which we never wanted or asked for. (maybe a little appreciation would be nice) Most of my sons childhood has been lost due to all of this, but that's ok God knows. God is able to restore these years.
